21 OCT 2024 Emergency Reference Sheet PUBLIC



In an emergency, make sure your family and home are safe, then check into the Sussex County Primary Repeater on 147.090 (+) MHz, PL 156.7 for instructions. The Secondary Repeater Frequency is 146.715 (-) MHz, PL 156.7. The Tertiary Repeater Frequency is 145.210 (-) MHz, PL 156.7 and the Primary County Simplex is 145.510 MHz. State Simplex is: 146.550 MHz.

NOTE: Program your radios to include a separate simplex channel for the OUTPUT frequency (147.090 MHz) of the Primary EMCOMM repeater; do the same for the Secondary and Tertiary Repeater Output Frequencies. This will be extremely helpful when repeaters fail. It will quickly put everyone on a simplex frequency until the repeater is restored or until your Net Control Station directs operations to an alternate repeater.

GUIDELINES FOR EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS

- 1. Check-in on the ARES Primary Repeater on 147.090 MHz** if you suspect a major emergency has taken place. Assume automatic net activation if regional electric, Internet, cellular or landline telephone service is not working. Non-ham frequencies to monitor are:
Emergency Alert System (EAS) Radio: WZBH 93.5 FM or WSSR 900 AM
Sussex County Fire Dispatch: 453.225 MHz/ Angola 453.700 / Sussex County Dispatch
National Weather Service: 162.475 MHz Salisbury, 162.550 MHz/ Lewes, 162.500 MHz/ Sudlersville
- 2. Listen to the Net Control Station** and direct all communications through the NCS.
- 3. Listen more than you talk;** strive for brevity and clarity. Use plain language and ITU phonetics; do not use “Q” signals. “Speak at writing speed.”
- 4. Formal messages must be written; use form ICS-213 and have the message signed by a supported agency official.**
- 5. Maintain an ICS-214 Activity Log. Create ICS-309 via RMS Express, Submit After Action**
